

Policy:	FOOD SAFETY CERTIFICATION POLICY

The Don't Go Hungry Food Support Program complies with the safe food handling regulations of the Province of British Columbia. Under the <u>Food Premises Regulation</u>, every operator of a food service establishment, and at least one employee in the absence of the operator, must hold a FOODSAFE Level 1 certificate, or a certificate from a course recognized as equivalent to FOODSAFE Level 1.

Every Don't Go Hungry site will ensure that there is at least one person on the site at all times who holds a FOODSAFE Level 1 certificate, or a certificate from a course recognized as equivalent to FOODSAFE Level 1.

All members of the Site Coordinator Teams are encouraged to have a current FOODSAFE Level 1 certificate. Other Station Leads, especially those handling food, are encouraged to have a FOODSAFE Level 1 certificate.
